

Dental disease in Guinea Pigs...

Guinea Pigs have continuously growing teeth, allowing them to eat fibrous and abrasive foods in their natural environment. Normally these teeth are worn down naturally, however if your Guinea Pig isn't receiving the correct diet, problems will start to occur.

Once your Guinea Pig has developed dental disease, there is no way to reposition the teeth into a normal alignment. So prevention is the key to having a happy and healthy pet.

Autumn resurgence in flea numbers...

Flea populations often subside over summer due to the excessive heat and the widespread usage of flea control products during spring, leading owners to forget about fleas.

However, Autumn and Winter conditions of between 20°C to 30°C and a relative humidity of more than 70 per cent are just about perfect for hatching and flea development, which can result in a spike in the size of the flea population. Remember that just 10 female fleas can multiply to more than 250,000 fleas in only 30 days!

Effective flea control all year round is the only way to keep on top of these pesky creatures. Ask us what the best method would be for your pet.
