



The gastric fundus moves ventrally and becomes located in the ventral abdomen.



The continuing gastric dilatation displaces the greater curvature ventrally.

Diagnostic Plan

- History
- Physical examination
- X-ray of the stomach
- Blood work

Therapeutic Plan

- Stomach distention relief
- Shock therapy
- Surgery

Dietary Plan

- A low-residue diet, fed in small portions
- Avoid excessive postprandial exercise
