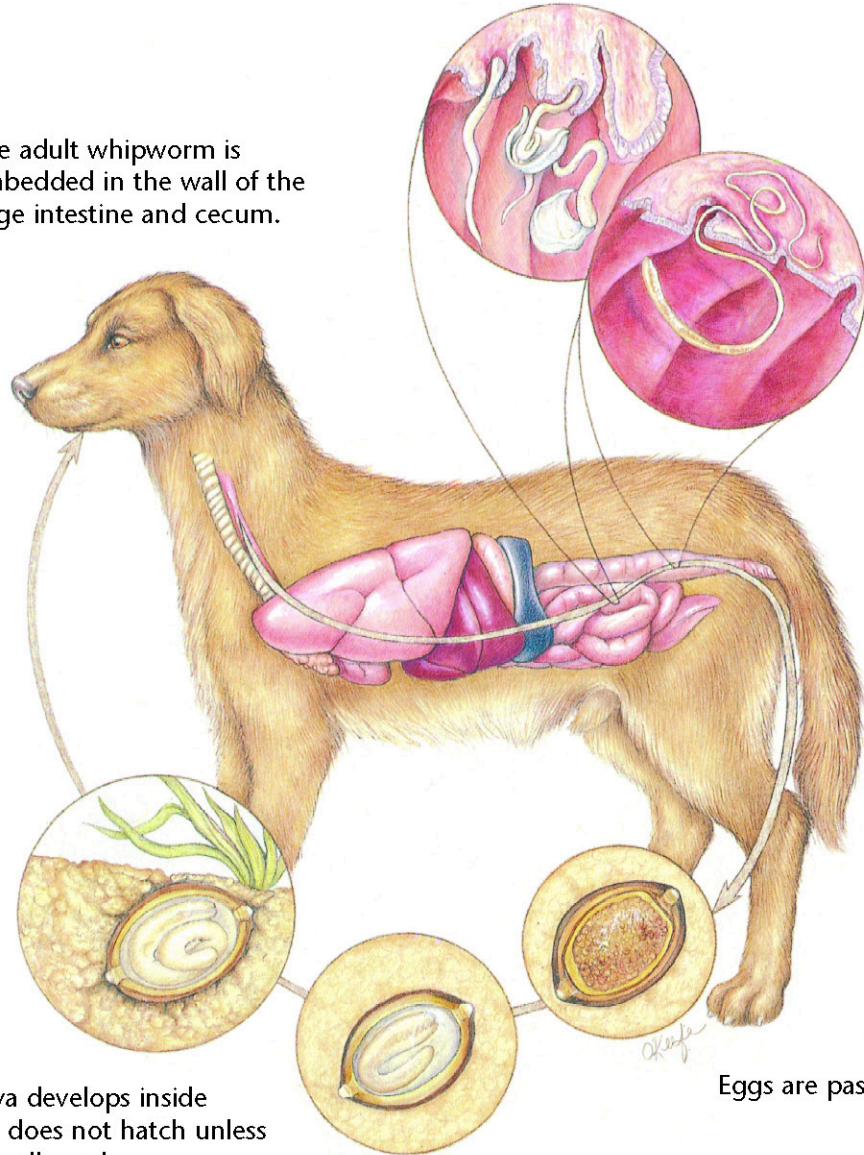


The adult whipworm is embedded in the wall of the large intestine and cecum.



Infected larva develops inside the egg but does not hatch unless the egg is swallowed.

Eggs are passed in the feces.
